Retirement Planning Council Retirement Readiness – pre planning

- 52% did not feel ready to retire.
- 55% were uncertain that 65 was the right age to retire.
- 44% people felt worried, apprehensive or indifferent about their retirement.
- 65% were most concerned about managing financially in retirement.




RPC Research Retirement Readiness – post planning

- 66% changed their mind about how they felt about retirement.
- 95% were excited and optimistic about retirement after the course
- 50% recognised the biggest challenge would be managing the transition to full time retirement.
- 25% were most concerned about financial issues



Longevity




Changes in Life Expectancy

- Life expectancy continues to rise in developed world.
- Average life expectancy for a male retiring at age 65 is now some 20 years in Ireland.
- For females its some 3 to 4 years longer.
- Probability of living to or beyond 90 is 47% for a man and 55% for a woman.




